

Installation Instructions – PM249

SLiC-610E rotary controller – Casambi enabled

Description:

The SLiC-610E is a Casambi enabled rotary controller, comprising a rotary encoder in a switch plate module and a SLiC-550E Casambi network adaptor. The SLiC-550E is installed behind the switch plate and sends signals to the Casambi lighting system. The Casambi App is used to configure the function of the Rotary Controller when the system is commissioned.

Commissioning:

1. Download the app from Apple App Store or Google Play Store and allow notifications and Bluetooth if prompted.
2. Ensure all Casambi enabled devices are powered on and open the Casambi app.
3. Create or select an "Evolution" network.
4. Give your Network a name, location and select if you want to share the network. There are 4 options here; Not Shared, Administrator only, Password protected or **Open**. For simple testing choose **Open**.
5. Click **Done** when you are happy with your settings and your Network will be established, allowing you to control all the Casambi devices in the mesh network.
6. Check that all the devices appear as "nearby devices" on the app.
7. Select the **SLiC550E-Rotary inc PB** and then from the prompt select **Add to 'your network'**.
8. Go to the **More** tab and select **Switches**. Then select the **SLiC550E-Rotary inc PB**.
9. Then scroll down to **ROTARY SWITCH** and change the function from **Not in use** to the desired action, e.g. **Controls all luminaires**.
10. Don't forget to press **Done**. Rotate the knob and the lights should dim up/down. All the lights in the network should cycle on/off each time you press the knob.
11. You can now access the luminaires tab, gallery and scene tabs, which will give you the chance to group luminaires, set scenes for multiple devices, initiate timers, sensors, relays and other devices on the network to personalise your lighting control. Then return to the switches tab to program each switch to control them.

Installation:

1. Ensure the supply is switched off during the install.
2. This device contains an Antenna – ensure the device is not installed adjacent to metal objects and wiring.
3. Insert the rotary-encoder module into your switch plate.
4. Connect the red and black cables to the AC supply (100-240V~).
5. Follow the commissioning instructions below.

Warning: do not connect the rotary encoder or the spare push-button switch to any other circuit.

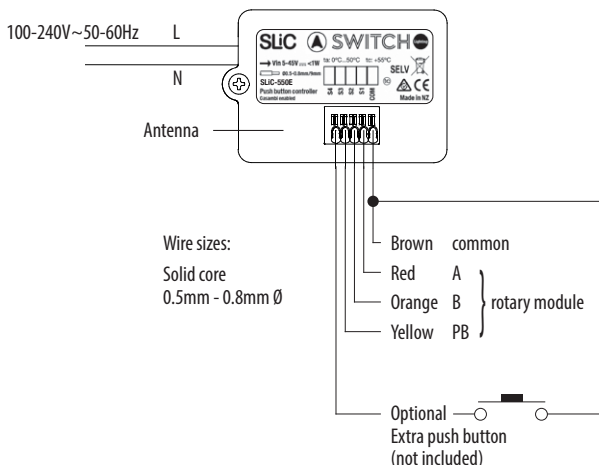


Danger: wiring to the push button must be insulated to the maximum supply voltage.

Note: the controller does NOT directly switch any lighting circuit, do not connect it to anything other than the SLiC-550E adapter as shown in the wiring diagram.

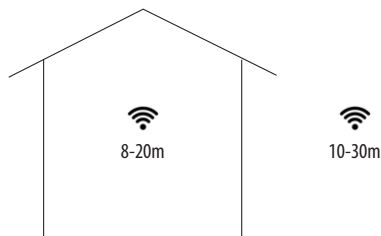
COM is internally connected to Neutral.

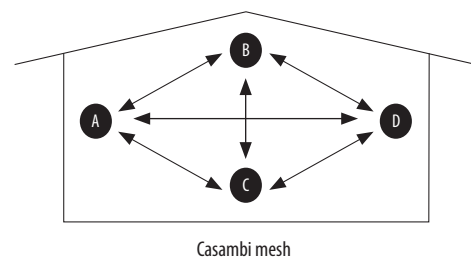


Range:

The Casambi system forms an interconnected radio mesh, so each unit also acts as a repeater, thus larger systems are easily achieved as long as at least one unit is no further than 8m from the next.



Range is highly dependent on surroundings and obstacles
